
The Gift of Life (GOL)

The first GOL sponsorship was open heart surgery for a Ugandan child, performed in 1974 at St. Francis Hospital on Long Island, New York.

Our own District 7190 became involved in the program in 1985 when it sponsored open heart surgery at the Albany Medical Center Hospital in Albany, New York for a young girl from Venezuela.

Since then the program has sponsored children from Korea, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Russia and Antigua. More recently we have contributed to programs in Bolivia and India. We also have gathered and shipped medical supplies and hospital equipment to healthcare providers in Peru, Mexico and Siberia.
